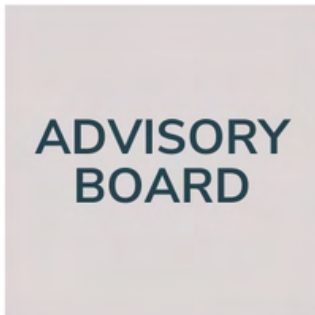

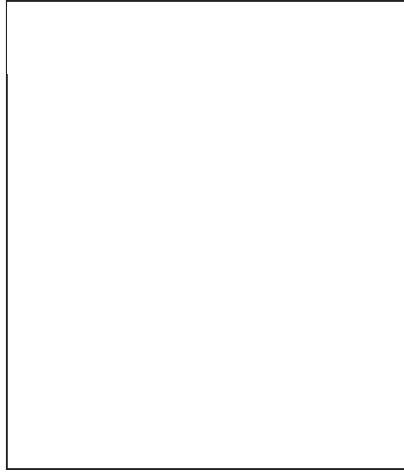

ROSWELL ARTS FUND ANNOUNCES NEW ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS



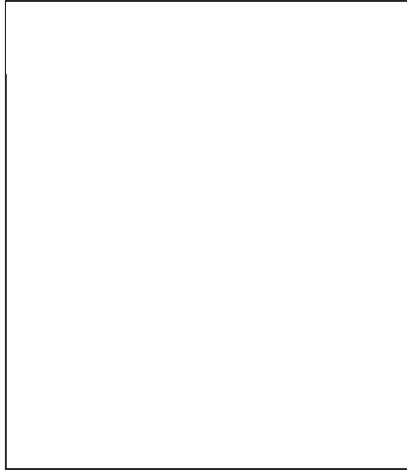
The Board of Directors of Roswell Arts Fund is delighted to announce the membership of the newly established Roswell Arts Fund Advisory Board.
