The third annual ArtAround Roswell Sculpture Tour, featuring 10 original works displayed throughout the city, will kick off with an opening celebration in April, the Roswell Arts Fund announced.

The opening is set for 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., April 14, at Riverside Park – site of a colorful, new, "Ice Pops" sculpture by artist Craig Gray. The family friendly ribbon-cutting will offer a live band, dance performances, interactive games, food trucks and arts and crafts activities. Mini-tours of ArtAround will be offered, with free shuttles provided.
